

Home Learning - Week 35

Welcome back, we hope you have all enjoyed a fun filled half term holiday; we have loved hearing about what the children have been up to!

This week we have started a new topic 'Under the Sea'. We have started by thinking about the children's own experiences of going to the beach and have read the story 'Sally and the Limpet'.

- This week we have written a list of things that we would need to take the beach in our beach bag. We sounded out carefully and wrote down the sounds that we could hear.
- We have listened to the story 'Sally and the Limpet' and have acted it out in our new beach role-play area using words and phrases from the story.
- We thought about what is special about our Dad's and other people who are special to us and have made them something very special out of clay.
- In Maths we have learnt about the numbers 19 and 20, and have represented them using Numicon, part-part whole, tens frames and objects. We also learnt about odd and even numbers.
- In PE we have practised some of the events that will be in our Sports Morning next week.
- In Letters and Sounds we have recapped all of the sounds and words that we have learnt so far and have practised writing longer covc and cvcc words.
