Morning and end of day routines

- Coats and bags in the cloakroom, lunches in the 'trug'
- Morning task
- End of day - children leave the classroom and walk independently to parents (or home, if appropriate)

Be ready, be safe, be respectful

- As a reminder, our school rules are be safe, be ready, be respectful.
- Our class have settled back into school life well and have been fantastic!
- If there are instances of not following the rules, the process is: reminder, warning, consequence. We move through these stages if the same behaviour continues. If we get to the consequence stage, we will email / phone home.

Home learning

- Home learning will still be set weekly.
- Children will be expected to practise their times tables (TT Rockstars – logins incoming!) and reading each day.
- Each week, the children will be set one piece of maths or English homework – this might be MyMaths, or paper-based learning. This is due each Friday and we will go through the answers together.
- After Christmas, the children will be given 'SATs buster' books for homework.

PE

- Our PE day will be on a Friday.
- Children come to school wearing their PE kit.

SATs

- Monday 10th - Thursday 13th May 2027
- Monday - spelling, punctuation and grammar
- Tuesday - reading
- Wednesday - maths (arithmetic and reasoning)
- Thursday - maths (reasoning)
- Friday - celebrate! Shared lunch / games
- Writing - teacher assessment. Your child will have a 'bank' of writing, finished in early June.

Trips / residentials

- September date TBC - visit to planetary lab 'There's no place like home' focussing on solar system / planets / climate change.
- November date TBC - trip to Exeter museum and cathedral (history and RE)
