This week in English we have practiced writing sentences using the subordinating conjunctions; when, if and after. We have written some fantastic clear instructions on how to make a pinch pot using imperative verbs to start our command sentences. We have made pom pom chicks in preparation to write our own set of instructions next week.

In Maths, we continued our learning of 'Multiplicative reasoning'. We have re-capped the different language for the multiplication symbol, we have written multiplication sentences to represent equal groups and have used and made arrays to match equal groups.
