#### **MATHS**

 Yr1: Count in 5s. Read and write numerals and words 1-20. Time - hours, minutes, seconds. Number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20. Recognise, find and name a half and a quarter as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity. Tell the time to the hour and half past.

Yr2: Use appropriate standard units to estimate/measure length, height, capacity, temperature. Recap crossing tens boundary in addition and subtraction. Adding three one-digit numbers. Position, direction and movement. Tell the time to 5 minutes, know the number of minutes in an hour/hours in a day.
