Our topic this week is 'The Gingerbread Man'. We have read lots of different versions of 'The Gingerbread Man'. Thank you to parents/carers who sent in their stories from home.

Activities/provision this week:

- Feed the fox maths game The children practised their counting by counting the number of buttons on each gingerbread man before feeding him to the fox.
- Rescue the gingerbread man The children used magnetic fishing rods to 'rescue' the gingerbread man from the river.
- Making a gingerbread house The children made a miniature gingerbread house using three biscuits, icing and buttons
- Gingerbread man sensory tray The children played with moon sand in a tray that looked like gingerbread. They explored the texture and used the cutters/rolling pins to 'make biscuits'.
- Gingerbread man stamping The children used gingerbread men cutters to paint on a large piece of black paper.
- Gingerbread Playdough The children used pretend baking trays, real rolling pins and gingerbread man shaped cutters to make their own gingerbread man.
- Gingerbread themed home corner The children pretended to make gingerbread themed foods and hot chocolates.
- Gingerbread Man small world play The children acted out the story using farm animals, puppets, a farmhouse and pretend grass/water.
- Christmas cards The children have started making their Christmas cards to send home for their families.

Phonics: Body percussion

This term our phonics focus is Body Percussion! The children are learning to develop their awareness of sounds and rhythm. They have been using their bodies to make different sounds e.g. tapping, stomping, clicking, clapping. We have been practicing making sounds slow, fast, loud and quiet.

Maths:

The children have been learning how to:

- Try and guess the number of objects by just looking at them (1-5 objects)
- Recognise how many objects are in a group without having to count them one by one (1-5 objects).

Next week the topic will continue to be: Christmas!
