



Home Learning

This week we have continued to learn about Traditional Tales. Our text this week has been 'The Gingerbread Man'

We have ...

- In phonics, we have learnt to recognise, read and write the digraphs: oi, ow and the tricky word 'you'
- We have learnt to retell the story of 'The Gingerbread Man' in sequence using small world, and dressing up in costumes and drew and labelled our own story map.
- We have observed what happened when gingerbread men fell into different liquids (water, lemonade, oil, vinegar). We made predictions of what we thought might happen next and talked about what we could see happening. We used vocabulary such as: **Liquid, observe, dissolve, float, sink, bigger, smaller**
- Practised writing the 'one armed robot letters'- h b, k, p and have tried hard to remember to start and finish in the correct place. We talked about using **ascenders and descenders** and starting and finishing our letters in the correct place.
- Practiced cutting accurately using scissors to making our own Gingerbread Man and decorated it using beads, buttons, stickers and shapes. We used the vocabulary: **cut, accurate, handles, blades, straight, curved**.
- In Maths we have continued to learn about repeating patterns. We identified patterns on everyday objects, identified, extended and created our own repeating ABB and ABBC patterns. We talked about patterns using the vocabulary: **pattern, extend, repeat, rule, extend, position**.
