This week we have continued our learning about Pirates!

- We drew and labelled a pirate treasure map, we sounded out carefully using all of the sounds we have learnt this year.
- We created our own pirate treasure boxes and strengthened the muscles in our hands when threading pirate necklaces.
- In PSHE we talked about our favourite memories of being in Codden class!
- In Maths we practised writing the numbers 0-10, starting and finishing them in the correct place. We counted forwards and backwards in sequence, identified missing numbers in sequences and sorted sequences of numbers into the correct order.
- In Letters and Sounds we have focused on writing sentences using all of the tricky words and sounds that we have learnt this year.
